# **Amendment to Consent Conditions**

### 1. Purpose

To obtain Committee approval to an amendment to the conditions for Consent WAR 950148 – Carterton District – Discharge of treated domestic sewage to Mangatarere Stream.

# 2. Background

- 2.1 This consent was approved by the Committee, at its meeting on 9 March 1999.
- 2.2 In the transfer of the report to the agenda, part of a condition was omitted which had been approved as part of the sign off by both submitters and the applicant.

### 3. Proposal

- 3.1 Condition 22 be amended by addition of the underlined words to read:
  - (22) Before 31 December 2002, the following effluent sampling quality criteria shall apply to the treatment plant effluent as sampled in the preceding condition. Compliance shall be based on a running geometric mean and ninety percentile calculated using 40 test results.
  - (a) Biochemical Oxygen Demand

The geometric mean of 40 consecutive  $BOD_5$  sample values shall not exceed 25 g/m<sup>3</sup> and no more than 10 percent of 40 consecutive values shall exceed 50 g/m<sup>3</sup>.

(b) Suspended solids

The geometric mean of 40 consecutive suspended solids sample values shall not exceed 45 g/m<sup>3</sup> and no more than 10 percent of 40 consecutive values shall exceed 90 g/m<sup>3</sup>.

(c) Faecal Coliforms

The geometric mean of 40 consecutive faecal coliform values shall not exceed 5,000 per 100 millilitres.

3.2 This amendment will be advised to submitters. The applicant has agreed to this procedure.

# 4. **Recommendation**

That the Committee approves the amendment, as contained in this report, and that this be advised to the applicant and submitters.
