## 1. **Consent Statistics**

The median processing time for non notified consents is 13 working days for the first six weeks of the year. This is because staff have been giving high priority to compliance.

## 3. Appeals

The Owhiro Bay boat ramp appeal is programmed to go to mediation on 9 September 1999.

We are in discussions over the Paraparaumu and Waikanae appeals. At this stage we have raised some issues and are waiting for KCDC to respond.

There were also two appeals on the PCC Sewage Decision. We have opened discussions with both appellants on these appeals.

## 4. **Compliance**

#### 4.1 General

Compliance inspections for the 1998/99 financial year have been completed and the results are presented to you in a separate report.

#### 4.2 Abatement Notices

We have issued three abatement notices to Burrell Demolition Limited and one of its Directors, Mr Alex Burrell, since the last meeting. They relate to a number of problems associated with the C&D Demolition Landfill (See prosecutions below)

On 23 July 1999 we also issued an abatement notice against Mr Bruce Lewin for stockpiling debris in the floodway of the Mangaroa River. Mr Lewin has now removed the debris and is complying with the abatement notice.

#### 4.3 Enforcement Orders

Anglian Water International (NZ) Limited and Wellington City Council (Moa Point Sewage Treatment Plant)

The application remains adjourned. We received an independent report into the odour issue and we are presently discussing a way forward with those affected.

The situation remains much improved on what we had this time last year.

#### 4.4 **Prosecution**

Following an extensive investigation we have laid charges against Burrell Demolition Limited and one of its directors Mr Alex Burrell. The charges relate to alleged breaches of the company's resource consent to operate a clean and demolition landfill.
