Pauline Nunns – Petone Water

Pauline Nunns explained to the Council her belief that the fluoridation of the water supply was a violation of her right to chose the chemicals she ingests.

Albert Landon – Petone Water

Mr Landon noted that Petone residents had already contributed though rates to the Te Marua lakes so had paid their dues to the Council. He asked for Justice and the refurbishment of the Buick Street Pumping Station.

Mary Burne – Petone Water

A resident of Petone for 17 years Mary Burne presented a list of studies which she said showed negative side effects from the addition of fluoride to water. Mary Burne added that as a matter of public health. The Council has no right to prescribe a medicine.

Mark Austin – Petone Water

Dr Austin informed the meeting that as a doctor with a particular interest in nutritional and environmental health, he is aware that evidence suggests fluoride does improve dental health. However, he also stated that evidence exists of potential side effects and it is of serious concern that there is a small margin of safety for its application

Jim Austin – Petone Water

Mr Austin asked the Council to be mindful that fluoridation could expose it to future litigation.

Peter Boolieris – Petone Water

Mr Boolieris asked the Council to review its fluoridation policy across the whole region.

Chris Horne – Transport Strategy

Mr Horne circulated a paper setting out his view that the Regional Land Transport Strategy was seriously flawed. He claimed that, if adopted, the Strategy would lead to more cars and negative environmental consequences long term. Mr Horne requested that the Strategy be sent back to the Regional Land Transport Committee.
