Regional Land Transport Strategy Hearing Subcommittee

Minute extract from meeting held on 1 June 2007

Consultation summary and recommended changes to the draft Regional Land Transport Strategy

Resolved (Cr McDavitt/Mayor Milne)

That the Subcommittee:

1. *Receives the report.*
2. *Notes the content of the report.*
3. *Agrees that the responses to submissions, as set out in Section 4 of this report, are appropriate.*

Moved as an amendment (Cr McDavitt/Mr Anderson)

4. *Agrees to recommend to the Regional Land Transport Committee the recommended final strategy as set out in Attachment 1, as amended to reflect the comments of the members of the Subcommittee.*
5. *Notes the Implementation and Corridor Plans document as set out in Attachment 2*

Moved as an amendment (Mayor Milne/Cr McDavitt)

6. *That 6. be amended to: Notes the Regional Transport Programme 2006/07 – 2016 as set out in Attachment 3*
7. *Notes that the implementation plans will need to be reviewed to ensure that they align to the new Regional Land Transport Strategy.*
8. *Agrees to recommend to the Regional Land Transport Committee the review process for the implementation and corridor plans as set out in chapter 13 of the recommended final strategy (Attachment 1).*

9. *Recommends that the Regional Land Transport Committee notes the draft process for prioritising the Regional Transport Programme provided in Attachment 4, noting that the detailed evaluation methodology is still to be developed.*

Asks Officers to prepare a communications strategy as part of the implementation of the Regional Land Transport Strategy.

11. *Recommends that the Chairman of the Regional Land Transport Committee be authorised to approve editorial amendments to the strategy, and final approval of the Subcommittee's report to the Regional Land Transport Committee.*
12. *Records its appreciation to Officers for the excellent work in responding to submissions and subcommittee deliberations, and in preparing a recommended final strategy.*
